Assessments will need to be rebuilt using the latest test bank within your new Twelfth Edition course.
- Custom gradebook configurations will need to be reapplied within your new Twelfth Edition course.
- Custom course topic blocks and organization of original Eleventh Edition content (e.g., chapters' resources combined into modules).

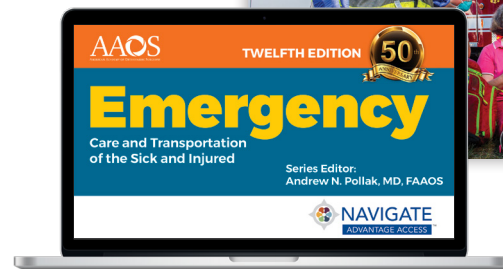
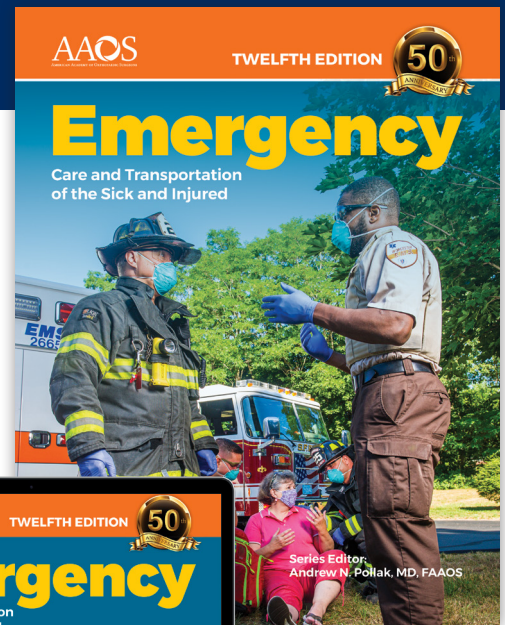
Course content that **CAN** be copied over:
